RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BIOLA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM GENERAL MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE USDA COMMUNITIES FACILITIES GRANT

WHEREAS, District staff identified a grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Development (the “USDA Rural Development”) to purchase, construct, and improve essential community facilities, to purchase equipment, and to pay related project expenses; and

WHEREAS, the USDA Rural Development provides affordable funding to develop essential community facilities in rural areas; and

WHEREAS, an essential community facility is defined as a facility that provides an essential service to the local community for the orderly development of the community in a primarily rural area, and does not include private, commercial, or business undertakings; and

WHEREAS, the Biola Community Services District is an eligible public agency/body under this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BIOLA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT HEREBY RESOLVES that:

1. The above recitals are true and correct.
2. The Interim General Manager of the Biola Community Services District is authorized to submit the application and any other supporting documents related to or supporting the application to the USDA Communities Facilities Grant.
