- 1. Proof of enrollment from your accredited college, university or vocational school.
- 2. Provide a sealed official copy of your High School transcript with weighted and unweighted grade point average.
- 3. Provide a letter of recommendation with contact information of the correspondent. The letter can be from a former or current teacher or counselor, volunteer work supervisor or employer.
- 4. In a separate sheet of paper provide a list in bullet format of campus activities, volunteer involvement, organizations/clubs you belong to and any special awards from your school or community organizations.
- 5. If the applicant's parents served in the U.S. Armed Forces please provide a copy of the Veteran's ID from the Veterans Administration or a copy of their DD214 (Please black out the social security number).
